

Dear Homeowners and Residents,

Our community is a wonderful place to enjoy walks with family, friends, and pets. To help ensure everyone's safety and comfort, we would like to remind all residents that dogs must be kept on a leash whenever they are outside their home or a securely fenced yard.

The City of Johns Creek Animal Control Ordinance (Chapter 10) requires that dogs not be permitted to run at large. When off the owner's property, dogs must be restrained by a leash no longer than six feet and under the control of a competent person.

Leashing your dog helps protect children, neighbors, and other pets; prevent unexpected encounters or accidents; and ensure everyone can comfortably enjoy our streets and common areas.

Even well-trained and friendly dogs can become startled or react unpredictably. Likewise, not every person or pet is comfortable with an unfamiliar dog approaching them. Keeping your dog leashed is a simple way to show consideration for your neighbors, while protecting your pet.

We appreciate everyone's cooperation in helping maintain a safe, welcoming, and enjoyable community for all.
